Counsel for the petitioners would state that in pursuance of interim bail granted vide order dated 16.07.2020, petitioners No.1 and 2 have already joined investigation. He would further inform that petitioner No.3 has been arrested in the case and his petition for grant of bail has rendered infructuous.

Counsel representing State of Haryana would concede to the position that petitioners No.1 and 2 have already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by the Court.

In view of the above, petition stands disposed of. Interim bail granted to petitioners No.1 and 2 is made absolute. Petitioners No.1 and 2 shall remain bound by the conditions, culled out in order dated 16.07.2020

passed by this Court. However, petition filed on behalf of petitioner No.3 is dismissed having rendered infructuous.
