The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 118 dated 1.6.2019 registered under Sections 323, 325, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Notice of motion was issued to State. Meanwhile, petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

On instructions from ASI Jagdeep Singh, learned State counsel submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 27.7.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
