1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.133 dated 24.11.2019, registered under Section 21 (subsequently Section 29 was added) of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar Rural .
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 16.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned AAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Lakhbir Singh, states that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 16.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned AAG, Punjab, order dated 16.07.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
