The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the respondents for taking appropriate legal action against the accused.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that his representation dated 27.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Mr. A.M. Punchi, PP, U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner. Let a complete copy of the paper book be supplied to the State counsel through e-mail or whatsapp during the course of the day,

failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 27.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
