Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.129 dated 01.04.2020 registered under Sections 379-B, 201, 34 IPC at Police Station Ladwa District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner herein has been in custody in the FIR in question since 01.04.2020. It is argued that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further contended that investigation is complete, as the challan has since been presented. Hence, the petitioner be enlarged on bail.

While opposing the prayer for the grant of regular bail, the learned State counsel has contended that there are serious allegations levelled in the FIR in question against the petitioner of not only snatching the mobile phone, wallet containing Rs. 8000/-, aadhar card and driving licence of the complainant, but also inflicting an injury on his head at the time of the occurrence in question.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Vijay Kumar has further apprised this Court that challan was presented before the trial Court in May 2020, however, charges are yet to be framed, which would be framed on the next date of hearing before the trial Court.

Heard.

In the present circumstances and in view of the allegations levelled against the petitioner in the FIR in question, which prima facie are serious in nature, no ground for concession of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the instant petition for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is hereby dismissed.
