Main case

Learned counsel states that inadvertently, certain material facts
could not be recorded in the petition. He seeks to withdraw the same with
liberty to file afresh, with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he
has instructions to state that as the petitioner is residing abroad, obtaining of

fresh power of attorney is difficult and a time taking process. Therefore, the power of attorney already made in his favour be treated valid for the petition to be filed with better particulars.

In the circumstances, the Registry is directed to treat valid the power of attorney already on record, for the purpose of the fresh filing as well. However, in case, the petitioner raises any objection to the same, then learned counsel alone shall be responsible for the consequences.
