The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners with a further direction to respondent Nos.4 to 7 not to interfere in their personal life and liberty and for direction to the official respondents Nos.2 and 3 to take action on their representation dated 13.07.2020(Annexure P-3).

Without making any observations as regards claim of the petitioners, but considering the fact that the petitioners are claiming in the petition that they have submitted a representation dated 13.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, UT, Chandigarh, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.-2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to take note on the representation(Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners and act in accordance with law.
