The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure on behalf of the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.0046 dated 29.04.2020, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot.

[2]. The petitioner is a woman and the FIR clearly goes to show that the allegation against her was of having raised a *lalkara* at the co-accused persons to attack the complainant/victim and she herself was carrying no weapon with her nor she had actually assaulted the victim.

[3]. The petitioner has remained in judicial custody for more than three months now, since 29.04.2020. Investigation against her has since been completed and challan submitted.

[4]. In view of the above circumstances, coupled with the fact that the

trial is likely to take its own considerable time to conclude due to the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, the petitioner, who is a woman, is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
