Petitioners have approached this Court with a grievance that despite the letter/order dated 18.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri-respondent No. 2, wherein the Pump Operator, Masons, Carpenters, Plumbers and Light Vehicle Driver working on contract basis are held entitled to payment of ₹14,500/- per month with daily wages of ₹558/- but they are being paid an amount of ₹5000/- per month. This is being continued by the respondents despite a categorical direction issued by the Deputy Commissioner.

Highlighting this aspect and putting forth their grievance, petitioners have submitted a representation dated 13.02.2020 (Annexure P-2) which representation has not been decided till date nor have the petitioners been granted the benefit which they are entitled to as per the letter/order dated 18.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy

Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Manchanda, Addl.

A.G. Haryana accepts notice.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri-respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation submitted by the petitioners dated 13.02.2020 (Annexure P-2) within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri-respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation submitted by the petitioners dated 13.02.2020 (Annexure P-2) within a period of four weeks from today. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioners is found to be correct, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to them within a further period of two weeks.
