Counsel for the petitioner would inform that in pursuance of interim bail granted vide order dated 27.07.2020, the petitioner has joined investigation and is ready to face the proceedings without any default.

Counsel representing State of Haryana would concede to this position but would oppose the application for grant of bail with the submission that in view of gravity of allegations raised against the petitioner coupled with that petitioner could not be taken in custody in the instant FIR despite issuance of repeated production warrants by the Magistrate, he is not entitle to concession of bail in anticipation of arrest.

The petitioner has already joined investigation. No substantial and justifiable reason is forthcoming with regard to necessity of custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, petition stands disposed of. Interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall

remain bound by the conditions, culled out in order dated 27.07.2020
passed by this Court.

Disposed of accordingly.
