The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 02.05.2020, in-laws of the petitioner administered phenyl in some drink of the petitioner. The condition of the petitioner became very serious and was hospitalized in DMC Hospital, Ludhiana for many days. Her statement was recorded by the police being MLC case. In-laws of the petitioner with all evil design entered into some compromise with the petitioner due to intervention of some respectables and they agreed to pay an amount of Rs.8 lacs to the petitioner on 10.06.2020 and thereafter, parties would separate in terms of their matrimonial status and the Istridhan would be returned to the petitioner. Thereafter, the commitment was not honoured by

the in-laws. The police has not taken any action despite recording of statement of the petitioner. Original compromise is also with the police.

Petitioner has already approached Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 11.06.2020 for registration of a criminal case against the private respondents, but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.A.P.S. Gill, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response as no order prejudicial to interest of any party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
