Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.22 dated 02.04.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Kurali, SAS Nagar.

Vide order dated 03.12.2019, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Pursuant thereto, parties have appeared before the Mediator and a report dated 20.12.2019 has been received from Mediation Centre wherein it has been reported that the parties have settled their disputes amicably and accordingly, settlement/agreement dated 17.12.2019 has been reduced into writing.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2, on instructions from his client, who is present in the Court, admits the very factum of the settlement.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.05.2019 is made absolute. The settlement/agreement dated 17.12.2019 shall form part of the record.
