This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 06.05.2020 under Sections 457 and 380 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

On 17.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

*“This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.55, dated 06.05.2020, registered under Sections 457, 380 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.*

*It has been contended by learned counsel that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR and that the same is an offshoot of a civil dispute between the complainant and one Pargat Singh over the property. It has further been contended that the complainant and the Pargat Singh have now entered into a compromise resolving their civil dispute qua the property.*

*Notice of motion.*

*On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jagmohan Singh Ghuman, DAG, Punjab has joined the session through Video Conferencing and accepts notice. On instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, he has confirmed that there has been a compromise between the complainant and Pargat Singh.*

*Adjourned to 07.09.2020.*

*Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to bail on furnishing adequate surety and personal bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. The petitioner shall abide by all the terms and conditions as specified under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has joined investigation and has fully cooperated with the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Jasvir Singh, has stated that the petitioner has since joined investigation on 06.09.2020 and he is no longer required for further investigation as of now.

In view of the above, the order dated 17.07.2020 is made absolute. The petitioner shall, however, join investigation as and when called. The petitioner shall also abide by all the terms and conditions as specified under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Disposed off accordingly.
