The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.326 dated 16.9.2018 under Sections 216/302/323/324/506/201/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal.

While praying for bail, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that material witnesses have turned hostile and the co-accused have been granted bail in view of the said statements.

Heard.

The case of the petitioner is different from the co-accused. The witnesses may lie but the circumstances speak for themselves. The petitioner is alleged to have given knife blow injury. The cause of death is also stated to be a stab injury. The said knife has been recovered from the petitioner. As per the FSL report, the blood was found on the knife.

No ground for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
