1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that petition U/s 438 Cr.P.C. qua petitioner No.1 has become infructuous as petitioner No.1 has been arrested, while qua petitioner No.2, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the same with liberty to petitioner No.2 to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail with a direction being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail on the same being filed, as expeditiously as possible.

3. The same is not opposed to by learned DAG, Haryana.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the petition U/s

while qua petitioner No.2 the same is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case, any application for regular bail is moved on behalf of petitioner No.2, the same be considered and decided by the learned trial Court, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
