Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 30.12.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the application has been filed with a prayer that respondent No.4 should not put pressure on the petitioner to compromise with respondent No.5, as CRM-M-40432-2017 praying for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise stands dismissed on 02.09.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Reply by way of affidavit of SP (D), Faridkot filed in the Court today, is taken on record, in which it is stated that application filed by the petitioner was marked to CIA Staff, Faridkot, where a complaint of respondent No.5 is also pending and during the inquiry, petitioner did not come forward to support his complaint and the same was filed. It is further stated that grievance

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of respondent No.5 is regarding fraud of Rs.6.00 lacs and trees worth Rs.3.00 lacs by the petitioner side with a false promise of compromise, which remained un-redressed and in this regard, the parties are filing complaints against each other.

After going through the contents of the petition and the reply, I find that no further action is required in the present petition.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of.
