CRM-M No.19276 of 2020

The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.131, dated 12th July, 2019, registered under Sections 307, 506, 328, 148, 149, 323 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bass, District Hisar.

2. The Petitioner has remained in detention since 21st May, 2020.
3. He was not named in the FIR nor any Statement was made against him by the Complainant.
4. After completion of investigation, Challan against the Petitioner has already been submitted.
5. In the circumstances, without commenting upon the other merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take a considerable time to conclude in view of the on-going Covid-19 Pandemic, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
