The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners have preferred this petition for issuance of necessary direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their lives and personal liberties from being invaded by the private respondents.

Notice of motion was issued on 17.07.2020. In the meanwhile, respondent No.2/SSP, Patiala was directed to look into the allegations of threat to the life and personal liberty of the petitioners and also to take necessary steps as may be required.

State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Bharpur Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Patran,

District Patiala. Para No.5 of the preliminary objections reads as under:-

“5. That apart from this, the statements of petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.2 were recorded by the police of P.S. Ghagga. Copy of the statement of petitioner No.1 is annexed as Annexure R-2/T and statement of petitioner No.2 is annexed as Annexure R-3/T. As per statements, the petitioners, they do not apprehend dangers from respondents no.4 and 5 (parents of the petitioner No.1) but they apprehend dangers from Kulwant Singh s/o Bhag Singh, Sukhjot Kaur w/o Kulwant Singh and Navpreet Kaur d/o Kulwant Singh r/o Kotra now resident of Sullar, Patiala District Patiala but they do not want any police protection from at their residence and for going and coming to house. Whenever they will need police protection, they will file another application. However, the police of P.S. Ghagga have provide mobile phones of SHO, PS Ghagga and other officials and the petitioners have been directed to contact the police officials in case of any requirement. Furthermore PCR officials of P.S. Ghagga have been directed to visit the house of the petitioners off and on”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of in terms of para No.5 of the reply.

Ordered accordingly.
