1. This petition has been filed for directing the respondent No.1 to pass appropriate administrative orders for making necessary arrangements for the hearing of the cases/appeals filed under the provisions of the Punjab Public Premises and Land (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1973 which are listed for hearing before the respondent No.3 i.e. Joint Development Commissioner (IRD) Punjab, since respondent No.2 i.e. Director, Department of Rural Development & Panchayats, Punjab who also sits in the same premises is stated to be indisposed on account of being infected with novel Carona Virus.
2. The precise case of the petitioner is that for the last 3-4 months the office of the Appellate authority was not functioning.
3. Notice of motion
4. Mr. Sahil Sharma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that in fact the office of respondent No.2 is

now open and the petitioner can file statutory appeal.

5. In these circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file proper proceedings on or before 21.7.2020 and in case the petitioner files any proceedings he may not be dispossessed till the decision of the stay application which he would file.

6. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application if any also stands dispose of.
