This is third petition for grant of bail to the petitioner pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.101 dated 17.4.2019 registered under Section 307, 379-B, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar. The first petition was dismissed on 10.12.2019 with the following order:-

“Prayer is for grant of bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0101 dated 17.04.2019 registered under Sections 307, 379-B, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

As per case of the prosecution, petitioner is supplying illegal arms to various criminals.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that apart from the present FIR, two other cases against the petitioner i.e. FIR No.101 dated

07.06.2019 under Sections 392, 120-B, 201 of the Indian Penal Code and 25 of the Arms Act and FIR No.112 dated 17.09.2017 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and 25, 27 of the Arms Act, are pending.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.”

The second petition for grant of bail was dismissed as withdrawn on 20.2.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a co-accused namely Shamsher Singh @ Sherry has been granted bail on 11.9.2019. The order dated 11.9.2019 is prior to order dated 10.12.2019. Still further, the petitioner is involved in two more criminal cases. Hence, no ground to grant bail to the petitioner is made out. Dismissed.
