LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioners seek protection of their life and liberty as they apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 and other relatives because they have married each other on 15.07.2020 against the wishes of the said respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners identifies both the petitioners, who are present in his office.

It is contended that the petitioners are major, their dates of birth being 14.01.2001 and 07.03.1996, respectively. True copies of Adhaar Cards of both the petitioners are appended with the petition as Annexures P1 and P2, respectively, though only year of birth has been mentioned in Annexure P1. A copy of the Marriage Certificate is on record as Annexure P-3. Petitioners, it is stated, submitted representation dated 15.07.2020

(Annexure P4) to respondent No.2 i.e., the Senior Superintendent of Police,

District SAS Nagar (Mohali) for redressal of their grievance but no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Advance copy of the petition already stands served.

Without commenting upon the age of the petitioners or the validity of their marriage or the validity and genuineness of the certificates/documents appended with the petition, respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) is directed to look into representation dated 15.07.2020 submitted by the petitioners and take appropriate action if any/as may be required, keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
