The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Article 226/227 Constitution of India for quashing of order dated 24.5.2018 (Annexure P-5) vide which the case of petitioner for promotion to the post of TGT Sanskrit was rejected.

On 17.7.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is working as JBT Teacher and his claim for promotion to the post of TGT Sanskrit has not been considered on the ground that he does not possess the requisite qualification of B.Ed. He has also placed reliance upon the decision of this Court dated 12.09.2018 passed in CWP No.12143 of 2016 titled as “Suresh Chander and others vs. State of Haryana and others”.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sharad Aggarwal,

AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and prays for time to file his response.

Adjourned to 28.09.2020.”

Learned counsel for the State on instructions has stated that the petitioner has been promoted to the post of TGT Sanskrit w.e.f. 8.8.2018 vide order dated 3.9.2020 and according to him, the claim of the petitioner made in the writ petition stands satisfied.

The above fact is not disputed by Mr. Malik, learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this writ petition. The same is disposed off as infructuous.
