Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that in pursuance to the order dated 17.07.2020 passed in **CRM-M-19271-2020** and order dated 14.07.2020 passed in **CRM-M-18595-2020**, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amandeep Kaur, submits that though the petitioners have joined the investigation but weapon has not been recovered.

It has already been observed in the order dated 17.07.2020 passed in CRM-M-19271-2020 that the licensed weapon was deposited in the gun house on 22.05.2020 i.e. prior to the date of occurrence.

In view of the above, order dated 17.07.2020 passed in **CRM-M-19271-2020** and order dated 14.07.2020 passed in **CRM-M-18595-2020**, vide which the petitioners were granted interim bail, are made absolute.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.
