Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This is the second petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to the petitioner during pendency of the trial in case FIR No.95, dated 23.09.2015, under Sections 399/402/411/413 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Having heard counsel for the parties at length, this Court is of the considered view that the present petition deserves dismissal.

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner is involved in a number of other FIRs and in relation to FIR No.137, dated 17.09.2015, his bail application already stands dismissed.

Insofar as the present case is concerned, petitioner had been granted the concession of bail but thereafter having abstained from trial proceedings, he was declared a proclaimed offender on 12.07.2018.

Conduct of the petitioner dis-entitles him from the concession of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
