Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 – Chimna Kaur, aged 19 years and petitioner No.2 – Paramjeet Singh, aged 20 years have got married against the wishes of their family members, arrayed as respondents No.4 to 8. It has further been submitted that the private respondents are threatening to interfere in the marital life of the petitioners. Hence, they are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 - Sr. Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar

Sahib to look into the representation dated 14.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the parties and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
