The present writ petition has been filed for setting aside the impugned order of premature retirement on the ground that no complaint whatsoever is pending against the petitioner and during his entire tenure, he has not faced any departmental proceeding or absented at any time.

Although the averments made in the petition in itself are not sufficient even to issue notice of motion.

State of Punjab had been provided advance copy of the petition. Accordingly, Ms. Lavanya Paul, AAG, Punjab is present in the meeting on the Video Conferencing. It is pointed out by the Ld. AAG on instructions from Mr. Sharanjeet Singh, Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Sangrur that the petitioner infact willfully absented himself for 1787 days. 91 times orders of censure and warnings were issued. Number of departmental proceedings were initiated during his tenure. Major punishments including forfeiture of service were also imposed. He has received adverse remarks in the ACRS for 1.4.2019 to January 2020.

In view of the said facts, the petitioner is not entitled for any relief. Moreover, the petitioner has not disclosed all these facts in the present writ petition. Thus, he is also guilty of concealing the facts and not coming to the Court with clean hands.

In view of the above, the present writ petition deserves to be dismissed with heavy costs but this Court restrains itself from doing so.

Dismissed accordingly.
