All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

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By this petition, the petitioner, Kavita Puri, seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.09, dated 04.01.2020 having been registered at Police Station City-2, District Mansa, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 306 and 149 of the IPC.

The petitioner is stated to be a lady with a minor child (other than her son who is a co-accused and has filed accompanying petition). Consequently, she having remained in custody for about 2½ months now, in an FIR alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 306/149 of the IPC, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the

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petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon her furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

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The petitioner in this case is alleged to be one of the 'main accused' who allegedly defrauded the deceased. Hence, after 2 ½ months of custody only, I am not inclined to admit him to bail at this stage.

Adjourned to 25.10.2020.
