**LISA GILL, J.**

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioners seek protection of their life and liberty as they apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 because they have married each other on 08.06.2020 against the wishes of the said respondents.

Both the petitioners, it is submitted, have solemnised marriage with each other out of their own free will and volition and it is their first marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners identifies the petitioners on the basis of the documents attached.

It is contended that the petitioners are major, their dates of birth being 15.11.1998 and 30.04.2001, respectively. True copy of Adhar card and PAN Card of petitioner no.1 and true copy of Adhar Card and school certificate

of petitioner no.2 have been appended with the petition as Annexure P-1 to P-4, respectively. Photographs of marriage and copy of the Marriage Certificate of the marriage is on record as Annexure P-6 and P-5, respectively. Petitioners, it is stated, have submitted representation dated 08.06.2020 (Annexure P-7) to respondents No.2 for redressal of their grievance but no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Lalit Kumar Gupta, Addl. PP for respondent -UT, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-UT. Advance copy of the petition already stands served.

Without commenting upon the age of the petitioners or the validity of their marriage or the validity and genuineness of the certificates/documents appended with the petition, respondent No.2—the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, is directed to look into representation dated 08.06.2020 submitted by the petitioners and take appropriate action if any/as may be required, keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall have no effect on the validity of the alleged marriage of the petitioners and neither will any other civil or criminal proceedings initiated against the petitioners be barred due to this order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
