LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of writ of mandamus directing respondents No. 4 and 5 not to threat, harass the petitioner or interfere in the peaceful possession of his property at the instance of respondents No. 7 to 12.

Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta learned counsel for the State was asked to seek instructions in this matter.

Mr.Gupta informs that as per telephonic conversation with the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, no representation whatsoever in this regard has been received in his office. It is, however, submitted that in case, any representation giving specific details of the concerned officials is submitted, necessary action, as required, shall be taken.

A perusal of this petition reveals that representation dated 01.07.2020 has been addressed to the Director General of Police (Punjab). The mode and manner of submission of this representation is not forthcoming.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with the observation that in case, the petitioner approaches

the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar and the Commissioner of Police, setting out his grievance alongwith details of the officials concerned within one week, the said representation be looked into and considered by the said authoritieswithin four weeks thereafter and necessary action, if any/as may be required be taken. Needless to say there is no expression of any opinion on the merits or genuineness of the averments.
