Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the search and release of detenue-Pinky Kaur.

The petitioner claims that she is legally wedded wife of the petitioner and is illegally and forcibly detained by the private respondents.

Keeping in view the assertions made on 16.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion.

On the request of this Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 to 4.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, office is requested to list the present petition in urgent on 17.07.2020.”

Smt. Pinky Kaur is present through video conferencing along with Sh. Saurav Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab.

This court has interacted with Smt. Pinky Kaur, who has categorically stated that she does not wish to reside with the petitioner and she is residing with respondent no.5 to 10 voluntarily.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Smt. Pinky Kaur is under threat from her parents.

Be that as it may. It is for the petitioner to prove that fact.

In these proceedings, it would not be appropriate for this court to go into the disputed questions of fact.

Keeping in view of the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of.
