Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.3 to 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.5 – Amarson filed a civil suit for permanent injunction against the petitioner, which was dismissed vide order dated 19.08.2019 (Annexure P-1) by the Civil Judge (Jr. Div.) Kaithal. Thereafter, an appeal was filed by respondent No.5 challenging the order of dismissal, which was pending before the Lower Appellate Court. However, ever since the dismissal of the suit for permanent injunction, the petitioner was being threatened by respondent No.5 of dire consequences and was being pressurized to compromise the matter with respondent No.5.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Ms. Dimple Jain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 - Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the representation dated 13.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of this order.

6. The present petition stands disposed of.
