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RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing (Webex App software).

Learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab, State of Haryana and Union Territory, Chandigarh, submit that all three of them are strictly complying with the MHA guidelines relating to the standard prescribed for the masks and sanitizers and the price of the same etc. They further submit that after the orders passed by this Court, they have conducted raids and have taken action against those who have over priced the masks and sanitizers or are selling the sub standard masks/sanitizers. It is submitted that they have constituted the teams which are continuously undertaking the exercise of monitoring the sale of masks and sanitizers and ensuring compliance of the MHA guidelines. All the counsel submit that they shall continue to do so to ensure that the requisite quality of masks sold by the chemists are not over-priced.

In view of the aforesaid statement of all the learned counsel appearing for the respondents, nothing further is required to be done in the present matter which is accordingly disposed of taking the statement of all the learned counsel for the respondents.
