The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of appropriate writ/direction for grant of revised pay-scale to the petitioner in parity with the pay-scale of Junior Assistant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the pay-scales of all categories of employees have been enhanced but despite the fact that earlier the pay-scale of Junior Assistant and the petitioner were equal, in the year 2011 the pay-scale of the Junior Assistant has been enhanced but the same benefit has not been extended to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contended that at this stage he would be satisfied if his legal notice Annexure P-3 is decided by respondent No.2 in view of the office order dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-8).

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has stated, on instructions, that he has no objection to the present writ petition being disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.2 to decide the legal notice Annexure P-3 in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

In view of the stand taken by both the counsel representing the parties, the present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice Annexure P-3 sent by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and keeping in view the office order dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-8), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The present writ petition stands disposed off.
