Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.177 dated 28.07.2018 under Sections 294, 384, 506, 509 IPC, registered at Police Station Dehlon, Ludhiana.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, submits that pursuant to the order dated 26.11.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation, all the three mobile phones have been recovered from his possession and custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

However, at this stage, learned counsel for the complainant while drawing the attention of the Court to the photographs attached with the application submits that in the light of photographs, wherein he is carrying weapons, petitioner is not entitled to be admitted on bail.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that pursuant to the order dated 26.11.2019, since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.05.2019 is hereby made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that in case petitioner extends any threat to the complainant or any other victims as referred in the FIR, the complainant would be at liberty to approach the SSP concerned, who shall look into such allegations and act in accordance with law.
