The present petition is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.126 dated 18.6.2020 under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Issue notice of motion.

Ms. Monika Jalota, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice.

The petitioner has been enroped on the basis of the statement made by the co-accused.

No other evidence against the petitioner has been pointed out.

Although, there is another one case pending against the petitioner but taking into account the facts of the present case as also the small recovery from the co-accused, the petitioner having enopred on the basis of the disclosure statement as well as taking into account that the petitioner is a woman, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to join the investigation and on her doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety

to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In case, the petitioner does not join the investigation or does not cooperate in the investigation or any further evidence becomes available against the petitioner, the respondent/State shall be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of her anticipatory bail.
