Affidavits dated 20.11.2019 as well as 12.12.2019 show that a field path was to be constructed at RD-4326 of Abul Khurana Outfall Drain as part of integrated project to address water logging problem in South Western Districts of Punjab, however, the complete project could not be implemented for various reasons including lack of funds and the project was closed on 31.3.2017. Thus, the field path at RD-4326 of Abul Khurana Outfall Drain could not be constructed. The petitioner and other similarly situated persons have an alternative route available through a village road crossing the said drain at RD-1815. Further, there was no existing field path at RD-4326 as claimed by the petitioner.

Thus, no further orders are called for. The writ petition stands disposed of.
