Prayer in this petition is for issuance of notice of contempt to the respondents for not complying of the order dated 10.6.2020 vide which it was directed that dues of salary be released to the petitioner by the respondent within two weeks.

Counsel appearing for respondent No.2 has placed on record order dated 17.7.2020 vide which the petitioner was transferred in the Office of District Attorney, Kaithal, in his home district, by granting relaxation in the online transfer policy of ADAs considering that he is a blind person. It is further stated that the salary amounting to Rs.2,51,000/- upto 19.7.2020 has also been released.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that since the entire salary is not released, he may be permitted to withdraw this contempt petition with liberty to file a representation to the concerned authority.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

The representation, if any filed by the petitioner, be decided within four weeks and, thereafter whatever is found due be released within a period of two weeks, thereafter.
