Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in FIR No.443 dated 29.12.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 506, 325, 34 IPC (Sections 325, 34 IPC added and Sections 148, 149 IPC deleted later on in final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.) at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a compromise has been entered into between the parties, which is dated 08.06.2020 (Annexure P-2). This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the complainant, rather he acknowledges the factum of compromise and states that he has no objection in case the prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the order dated 17.07.2020 passed by this Court in *CRM-M No.17075 of 2020* titled as *Sahil @ Ashish @ Guttu Versus State of Haryana*, wherein the co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the benefit of bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panchkula.

Any observations made hereinabove are for the purpose of disposal of the present petition alone and shall have no bearing on the merit of the case during the trial in any manner.
