Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.60 dated 18.07.2018 under Section 498-A, 406 IPC and Section 3 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Section 313 IPC (later on added) registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 12.09.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jasvir Singh, PS Sadar Ahmedgarh, Sangrur, states that the petitioner has since been declared innocent by the Investigating Agency during the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
