GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to apply for grant of regular bail. It has further been submitted that the matter in fact has been amicably resolved amongst the parties and that the complainant does not have any objection for grant of bail to the petitioner.

At this stage Mr. Mukesh Kumar Bhatnagar, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has endorsed the fact that the matter has indeed been compromised amongst the parties.

In view of the aforesaid submission made on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and applies for grant of regular bail in the Forenoon of the day, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously on the day of filing of such application while considering the contention of the petitioner that the matter has been amicably resolved.
