This is third petition for grant of bail to the petitioner pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 105 dated 8.3.2018 registered under Section 22 of The NDPS Act, at Police Station Saleb Tabri, District Ludhiana.

There is a recovery of 330 grams of Heroin (Narcotics) in the present case. Two previous petitions were withdrawn by the learned counsel for the petitioner after addressing arguments.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that the prosecution has already concluded its evidence and the case is now fixed for defence evidence.

In view of the aforesaid facts, this Court does not consider it appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

Hence, dismissed.
