Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.380 dated 05.10.2019 registered under Sections 279, 336 IPC and Section 11 of Prevention of cruelty to animals Act, 1960 and Section 13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh-Mewat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the instant case on the basis of a fabricated version. He further contends that the learned Court below while passing the impugned order of dismissal of his bail application erred in observing that the petitioner was involved in as many as four cases of similar nature, which was factually incorrect. In fact the petitioner was involved in just one more case of a similar nature.

Learned State counsel, who is already in receipt of advance

copy of paper book, has vehemently controverted the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupender has apprised this Court that in fact the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in the following cases:

1. FIR No.366/2016 registered under Section RNG. PS Nowgama District Alwar
2. FIR No.51/2017 registered under Sections 5/13(2) HGS and GS Act at PS Pingwan
3. FIR No.65/2017 registered under Section HGS and GS Act at PS Pingwan
4. FIR No.134/2018 registered under Sections 279, 336, 120-B IPC and 5/13(2) HGS and GS Act , 11.59.60 AC. Act at PS Firojpur, Jhirka.

In the circumstances, no ground is made out to extend the extra ordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
