(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioner has filed the present petition for issuance of writ of certiorari for quashing of order dated 29.02.2020 passed by respondent No.1 qua the petitioner, vide which, the request of the petitioner for his transfer from Sessions Division, Mewat at Nuh to Sessions Division, Gurugram has been rejected despite the fact that his case is fully covered under Rule 10(3) of the Haryana Subordinate Courts Establishment (Recruitment and General Conditions of Service) Rules, 1997. The petitioner has also sought further relief of his transfer from Sessions Division, Mewat at Nuh to Sessions Division Gurugram.

Mr. Gaurav Chopra, Advocate has appeared for respondents No.1 to 3 and undertakes to file his power of attorney in the registry.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has, on instructions from the petitioner, submitted that the petitioner will be satisfied in case his request is considered afresh sympathetically by the appropriate authority after some time and that the petitioner will

accept the order passed on such consideration as final.

Learned Counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 has no objection to such fresh consideration of request of the petitioner by the appropriate authority after some time.

In view of statement of learned counsel for the petitioner and the facts and circumstances of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with the observations that request of the petitioner for his transfer from Sessions Division, Mewat at Nuh to Sessions Division Gurugram may be considered a fresh by the appropriate authority as expeditiously as possible and that the petitioner shall be bound to accept such decision as final.
