The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.70 dated 29.1.2020, registered at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307 and 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for over six months and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as even, charges have not been framed as yet. No specific role has been attributed to the petitioner in the FIR and thus, he may be released on regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 9.9.2020 has been presented in Court and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 06 months and 22 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Regarding the status of the trial, learned State counsel concedes the submission in this regard of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Thus, it is evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and keeping in view the custody period already undergone by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the

petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his
