AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court challenging the order dated 03.06.2005 (Annexure P-6) vide which the deemed date of promotion of the petitioners as Senior Assistant has been treated as 30.11.1994 and 10.10.2001 instead of 11.05.1989 and 13.01.1992 respectively thereby virtually putting the petitioners juniors to the persons, who were earlier juniors to them in the feeder cadre, to be not sustainable.

2. On the last date of hearing, it was asserted that the claim of the petitioners, as made in the present writ petition, is covered against them by the Division Bench judgment of this Court in *CWP No.8699 of 2005* titled as *Jai Pal and others Versus State of Punjab and others*.

3. I have considered the pleadings in the case and also considered the submissions of the counsel for the parties.

4. On going through the judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court in Jai Pal's case (supra), I am satisfied that the claim of the petitioners is covered by the said judgment against them.

5. In the light of the Division Bench judgment of this Court in Jai Pal's case (supra), the present writ petition stands dismissed.
