The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No. 36 dated 27.05.2020 on the file of Police Station Mukandpur, Nawanshahr, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC; Section 61/1/14 and 78(2) of Punjab Excise Act, 1914; and Section 181 of The Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

The petitioner was not named as an accused initially and seems to have been implicated by the disclosure statement of one of the co-accused. One of the co-accused of the petitioner has also been granted anticipatory bail.

Given the aforesaid facts, this Court is of the opinion that it would suffice if the petitioner joins and co-operates with the investigation.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No. 36 dated 27.05.2020 on the file of Police Station Mukandpur, Nawanshahr, subject to the petitioner furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioner shall also comply with the mandate of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
