Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and to not to interfere in their peaceful married life at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 10.

On 20.07.2020, learned State counsel was directed to verify the facts and existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Shri Rahul Bhardwaj, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Abohar, District Fazilka on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1, have produced their affidavits stating therein that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and will not interfere in their married life.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
