Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage on 16.07.2020 against their wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners are receiving threats from the private respondents. It is pointed out by him that the advance copy of the petition was supplied to the office of Advocate General, Punjab on 18.07.2020.

At this stage, Mr. Harsimar Singh Sitta, AAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of the State and has apprised the Court that statements of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.5 have been recorded. Petitioner No.1 in her statement has stated that she has no threat from private respondents

whereas respondent No.5 stated that she has no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication and the petition is rendered infructuous.
