Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the counsel for
the respondent submit that they seek early decision of the appeal, which is
pending before the learned Appellate Education Tribunal, Gurugram, now
for 13.08.2020.

2. It is contended by the counsel that the issue involved in these

cases are identical and even the application appeared to be by and large common except for the records, which may be summoned by the Court in case applications preferred by the respondent are accepted. It has also been accepted by the counsel for the parties that they would not seek any adjournment before the Appellate Tribunal and make an endeavour to get the proceeding before the Appellate Tribunal completed at an early date and in any case within a period of two months from the next date of hearing. Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that the petitioners have already submitted their written arguments before the Appellate Tribunal on 01.07.2020 with advance copy to the counsel for the respondent before the Tribunal, which may be taken into consideration by the Appellate Tribunal while deciding the appeals.

3. Keeping in view the submissions made by the counsel for the parties and the grievances, as have been highlighted by the petitioners in the present revision petitions, the Appellate Tribunal under the Haryana Education Act, is directed to decide the appeal preferably within a period of two months and in any case not beyond a period of three months from the next date of hearing.

4. The revision petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
