Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for placing on record the documents (Annexures R/1 and R/2) and exemption from filing certified copies thereof.

Application is allowed, as prayed for and the documents (Annexures R/1 and R/2) are permitted to be taken on record.

CRM-17043-2020

Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for exemption from filing the prescribed court fees and original power of attorney.

Prayer for exemption of court fee/document on account of COVID-19 is accepted with the condition that the petitioner shall deposit

the required court fee/document within a period of one month when the situation becomes normal from the COVID-19 effect.

Application stands disposed of.

CRM-M-19639-2020

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.107 dated 21.06.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC (the offence under Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Moohana, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 20.07.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.07.2020, is hereby made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
